

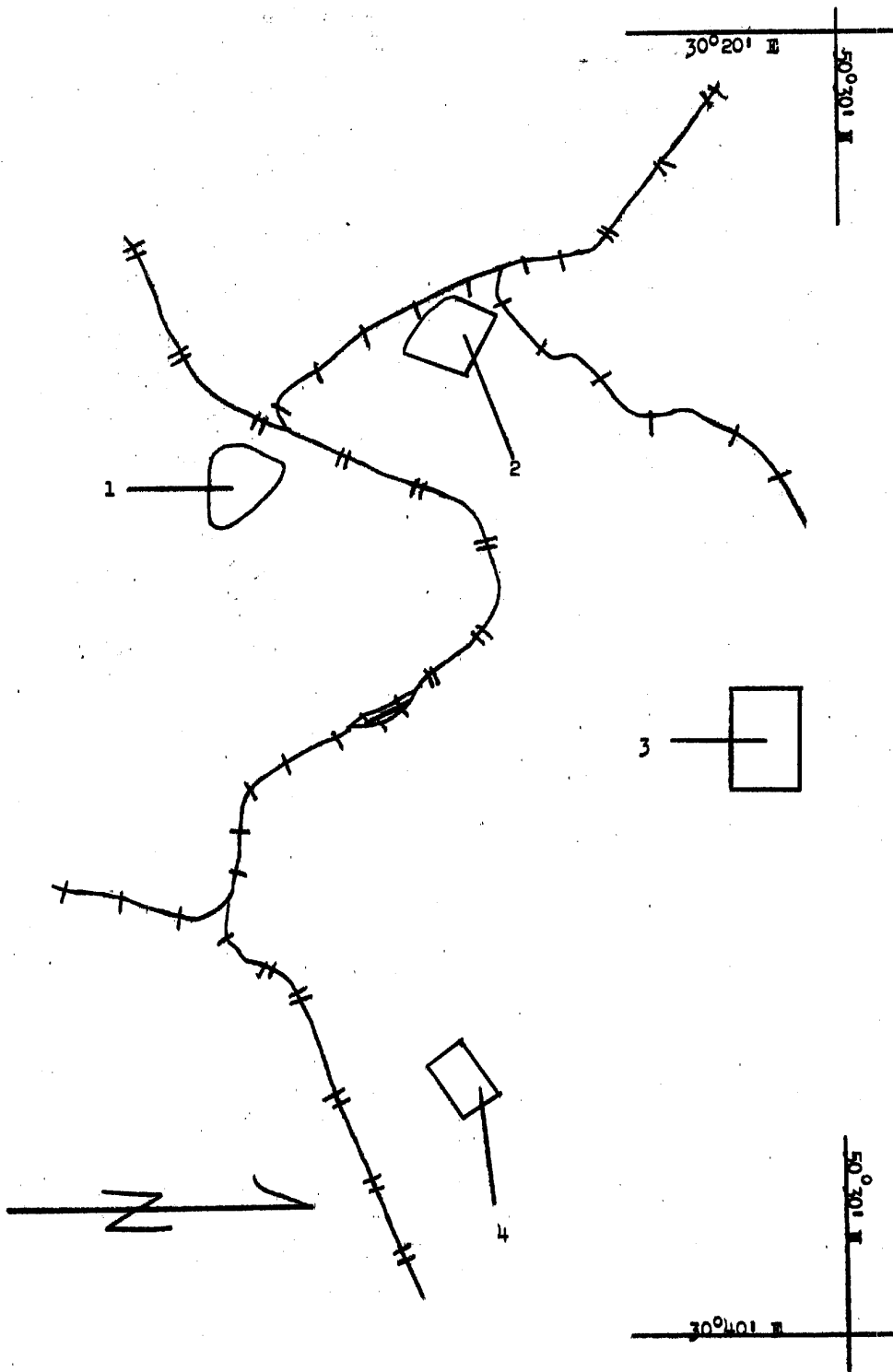

ENCLOSURE A: (CONT'D)

LEGEND

- 50X1 Point # 1. Military Airfield: [] observed this airfield many times from a train. His observations were obstructed and limited, but he saw various types of conventional single and multi-engine military aircraft. He saw no jet aircraft.
- 50X1 # 2. Civilian Airfield: known as Tsentral'niy Aerodrom /Enclosure R/, which was the main civilian airfield in Kiev. [] landed as a passenger at this airfield many times. Only C-47 type passenger aircraft were based at this field, no military aircraft whatsoever.
- 50X1 # 3. Military Airfield: approximate location; many times, while bathing at a beach in the vicinity, [] observed conventional-type aircraft as they landed and took off. He never saw jets in the area.
- # 4. Civilian Airfield: known as Malen'kiy Aerodrom; approximate location; it was a smaller airfield than the Tsentral'niy Airfield (Point No. 2).

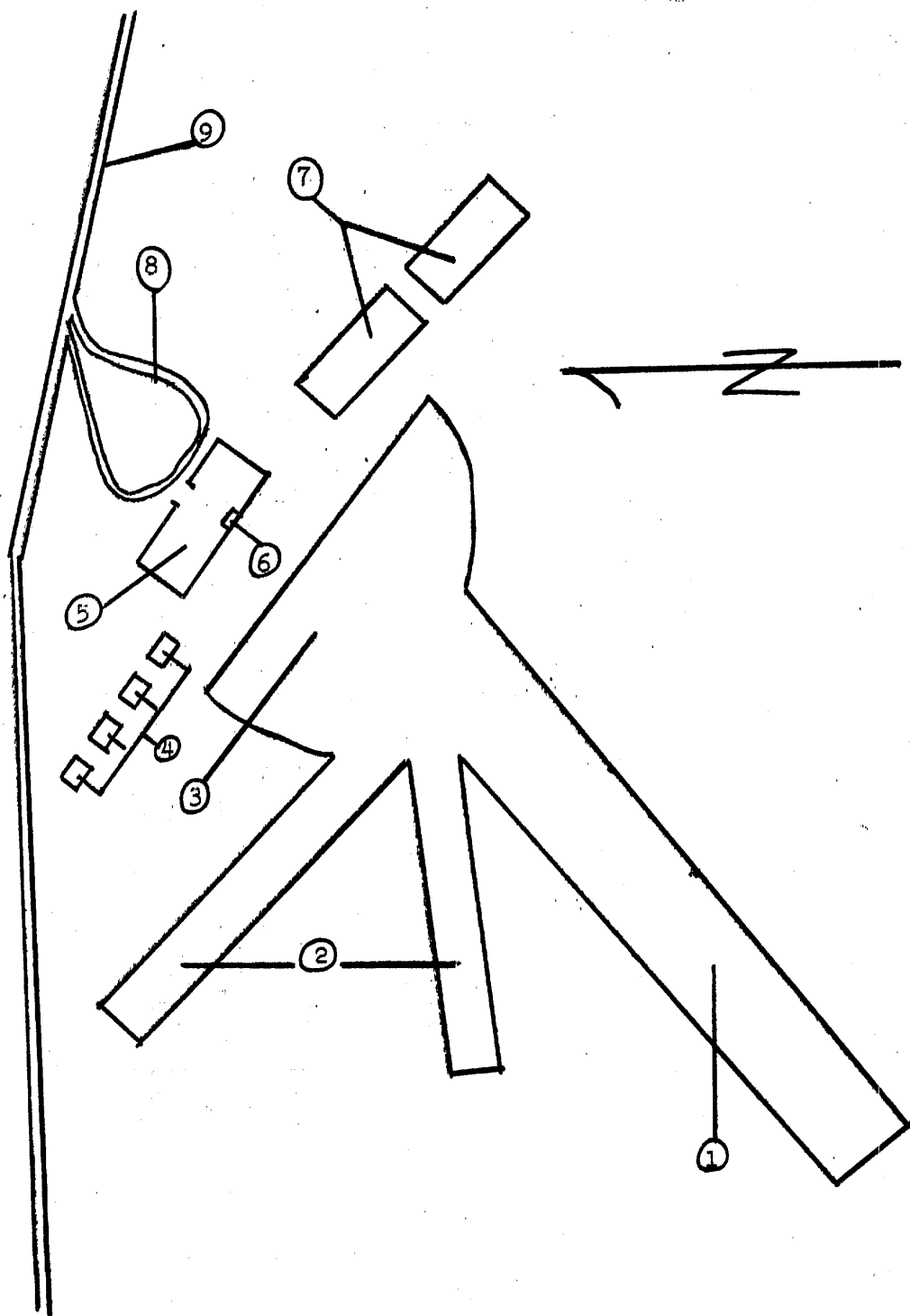

ENCLOSURE B: (CONT'D)

LEGEND

- Point # 1. Runway: concrete, 500 m. long, 20 m. wide, running north-east to southwest.
- 50X1 # 2. Runways: runways for smaller liaison-type aircraft. However, as a passenger, he never landed on either of these runways nor observed any landings on or take-offs from them; concrete, 200 m. long, 10 m. wide, one to the east-west and the other to the northwest-southeast.
- # 3. Concrete Parking Ramp.
- # 4. Buildings: one-story, wooden structures, eight by five by four meters.
- # 5. Terminal Building: one-story, stucco, brick, 40 x 15 x 5 m., slightly-pitched tile roof; contained waiting room and operations room.
- # 6. Control Tower: located on top of terminal building, four by four by six meters, stucco, brick, uppermost 1.5 m. enclosed on four sides by glass.
- # 7. Hangars.
- # 8. Asphalt Driveway.
- # 9. Zhitomerskoye Doroga: asphalt, 6 m. wide, from airfield to Kiev.
